The undersigned, as part of this application for stabling any or all of the horses listed herein at Sunland Park Track for the 2007-2008 season, and in consideration of the rights and privileges that may be granted pursuant to this application, does hereby agree to the following terms and conditions. **(1.)** My Way Holdings, LLC. reserves the right to cancel this application for stable space in whole or in part, or to refuse the acceptance of any entry in any race at any time for any reason or cause and without notice to the undersigned. **(2.)** The undersigned agrees: (a) To abide by all rules and regulations of My Way Holdings, LLC. pertaining to the stabling, occupancy and the use of premises at Sunland Park, including rules and regulations contained in the Sunland Park Condition Book. (b) To vacate the stalls and move any or all horses, equipment, property and personnel off the premises at Sunland Park within three (3) days after requested to do so. **(c) My Way Holdings, LLC., its agents or employees, will not be liable or responsible for any injury or loss suffered in any manner by or to undersigned or other injury or loss by or to the horses, equipment, or other property of the undersigned or of personnel, agents, employees, or invitees of the undersigned, while on or off the premises of while being transported in any manner on or off the premises, or related to or resulting from practicing or taking part in physical training, a sport or athletic activity or contest, including the exercising, racing and/or caring for horses (d) That the undersigned hereby releases My Way Holdings, LLC., its agents and employees from and against all claims of such injury or loss by or on behalf of the undersigned. (e) To save and hold My Way Holdings, LLC., its agents and employees, free and harmless from all losses, costs, damages, liabilities, expenses (including attorneys fees and expense of any nature), due to or arising out of or from the stabling and/or action of horses or other animals of or in charge of the undersigned at Sunland Park, or from the use or occupancy of the stalls or premises, or by reason of any acts, conduct or negligence of the undersigned or any of his employees, agents, or invitees. (3.)** No stabling will be permitted except in accordance with this application, and no entry in any race will be received except upon conditions that all disputes, claims, and obligations arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of any rules or conditions or races otherwise shall be decided by the

New Mexico State Racing Commission, the Stewards of the meeting or My Way Holdings, LLC., as the case may be and such decisions upon all points shall be final. **(4.)** In all stakes races, acceptance must be made through the entry box by a specified time before the race. **(5.)** Any stalls not filled by the assigned trainers will revert to management. See back of application. **(6.)** All stabling and all entries in all races are received and accepted subject to all conditions, rules and regulations of the New Mexico State Racing Commission and of My Way Holdings, LLC., including, but not limited to, a Commission rule ordering that no stalls with horses are to have padlocks. **(7.)** No payment of any nomination or eligibility fee for any stakes race shall entitle a horse to stabling at Sunland Park. **(8.)** My Way Holdings, LLC., its agents, employees, or designees, may desire to televise directly or by photographic transcription all or some of the races at Sunland Park, and reserves all rights to reproduce, transcribe or transmit such races directly by television or otherwise. Entries will be accepted only on the condition that if requested by My Way Holdings, LLC., the owner, the jockey, the trainer, the groom and all other employees of the owner of trainer coming within view of the television cameras will sign and deliver to My Way Holdings, LLC. consents or releases, permitting such television and the exhibition thereof in any manner at any time. **(9.)** The undersigned represents that he/she and all for whom he/she is acting, have read or will familiarize themselves with The Rules of Racing and the regulations of the New Mexico State Racing Commission, the horse race officials, the Sunland Park Condition Book and this application, and agrees to be bound thereby, and further agrees that all animals shall be subject to such rules and regulation and to the acts and decisions of the race officials. **(10.)** The undersigned represents that he/she has the right to make the above representations with respect to every owner of every horse listed herein, and that each such owner will be bound hereby. **(11.)** All horses whose stall applications are accepted are subject to veterinarian's examination. Any horse not in condition to run during the meeting will not be stabled at Sunland Park. **(12.) No additions or improvements to the stalls or premises shall be made without prior written approval of My Way Holdings, LLC. (13.)** The undersigned agrees to maintain the stalls and premises in a clean and orderly condition at all times, and to place all manure and debris in the garbage containers on a daily basis. YOUR COOPERATION IN ALL MATTERS WILL BE GREATLY APPRECIATED.

ALL FOAL CERTIFICATES MUST HAVE CURRENT COGGINS TEST UPON ARRIVAL.
CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATES ARE ALSO REQUIRED ON EACH HORSE.

SUNLAND PARK SCREENING RULES FOR THE 2007-2008 RACING SEASON

1. Only two year olds (foals of 2006) that are registered New Mexico bred or are nominated to a race at Sunland Park will be allowed to occupy stall space.
2. No maiden quarter horses older than four years old. No maiden thoroughbreds older than five years old.
3. Any horse placed on the poor performance list twice during the meet will be ineligible to start and must be removed from the grounds.
4. Any horse that has started for a claiming price of \$4,000 or less, must have finished first, second, third or fourth for \$4,000 or higher since starting for \$4,000 claiming or less in 2006-2007. Maidens that have started for a claiming price of \$6,250 or less must have finished first, second, third or fourth for \$6,250 claiming or higher since last starting for \$6,250 claiming or less in 2006-2007.
5. Minimum claiming price is \$5,000.

POLICIES FOR THE 2007-2008 RACING SEASON AS ADOPTED BY THE NEW MEXICO STATE RACING COMMISSION.

1. If the trainer has not bedded assigned stalls or made arrangements with management to show intent or occupying stalls, the stalls will be reassigned after the first race day.
2. Screening rules will be approved by each individual track's local committee and must be approved by the Racing Commission. (See screening rules)
3. No mandatory stall limits; each track will allocate number of stalls at their discretion.
4. In slips and out slips will be required on all horses.
5. Stalls will be allocated based on balance of application and quality of past performances supplied with application.
6. All applications will include past performances of all horses and current license of the trainer applying.
7. New Mexico Breds on each application shall have preference over horses of comparable quality.
8. Poor performance standards will be enforced at the current meet for a horse who runs at the bottom claiming price in their last four starts and does not place first, second, third, or fourth at the discretion of the Racing Secretary and Stewards.
